
Multicolor Boat Lighting Kit Installation Instructions

- 1) Determine mounting locations for the strips.
 - Most people prefer to mount the strips under the gunnel spaced evenly around the perimeter of the boat. This will give you a nice accent lighting around the entire interior of the boat.
 - Other options include under the seats or dashboard. When mounting under seats you can run into an issue with hiding wires.
 - You can cut the strips down every few LEDs and re-solder wires to the copper contacts as needed.
 This is only recommended for professional installers with experience micro-soldering and heat-shrinking.
- 2) Securely mount the strips by peeling back the paper backing on the double-sided tape and pressing them into place on a clean smooth surface. For added strength, apply silicone gel along the outer edges of the strip.
- 3) Connect the power wires to the battery and wire the fuse in-line with the negative wire terminal. Plug the wireless controller receiver into the jack coming from the battery.
- 4) The output end of the controller is then plugged into the 4-prong plug on one end of the strips. You should now be able to power on the strips using the wireless remote.

Troubleshooting

- 1) Strips don't turn on.
 - a. Make sure the battery is charged. Using a voltmeter test that there is a sufficient voltage coming from the battery.
 - b. Connect the main power wires directly to the battery bypassing the fuse. If it works, there is an issue with the fuse.
 - c. Change the remote battery.
